Download with caution: Think first. Click later.

Your computer should now be well-defended, although no technology can protect it against every danger. And that's where you come in.

Consider the following list before you click an attachment (or link) in an e-mail or instant message, download a file from a Web site (or a pop-up ad), or share music or other files from a stranger's computer.

If you know the sender but the message arouses your suspicions here are some ways to identify fraudulent e-mail

1. Pause before you open attachments and click links

Never open attachments in e-mail or instant messages from strangers.
